
Profile of the 8th Goa Legislative Assembly


The results of the elections to the 8th Goa Legislative Assembly were declared today. There are 40 assembly seats in the state. In this note, we analyse data on the profile of the incoming Members of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) and compare it with the previous Assembly.

Bharatiya Janata Party has the highest seats at 20; Indian National Congress has 11 seats


