The Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh Bill, 2008

- The Standing Committee on Health and Family Welfare submitted its 33rd Report on 'The Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh Bill, 2008' on December 18, 2008. The Chairperson was Shri Amar Singh.
- The Committee welcomes the proposed Bill but makes certain recommendations.
- The PGIMER does not run undergraduate courses because it was envisaged to be a postgraduate institute. The Committee recommends that institute should take necessary steps to start MBBS course at the earliest so that the available resources are optimally utilised.
