THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF MEGHALAYA (MEMBERS' SALARIES AND ALLOWANCES) (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2016

Bill

further to amend the laws relating to the salaries and allowances of the Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya (Members' Salaries and Allowance) Act, 1972.

Be it enacted by the Legislative of the State of Meghalaya in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows,-

Short title and commencement

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya (Members' Salaries and Allowance) (Amendment) Act, 2016.
 - (2) It shall come into force on such date as the State Government from 1st October, 2016.

Amendment of Section 4 of Act 8 of 1972

2. In Section 4 of the Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya (Members' Salaries and Allowance) Act, 1972, in existing clause (b) after the existing last word "members", occurring in the fifth line, the comma (,) shall be added and the following words shall also be added, namely,-

"including in the various Committees of the Legislative Assembly".

STATEMENT OF OBJECT AND REASONS

The object of this Bill is to amend the Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya (Members' Salaries and Allowance) Act 1972. In Section 4 of the Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya (Members' Salaries and Allowance) Act 1972, the existing clause (b) is proposed to be amended to give more clarity so as to provide to Members the daily allowance as prescribed in this Clause (b) including for attending duties in various Committees of the House. With this proposed amendment the Members of the Meghalaya Legislative Assembly will be entitled for daily allowance for attending in the Committees of the House at the rate of Rs. 600/- per day.

Hence, the Bill.

THE MEGHALAYA PARLIAMENTARY SECRETARIES (APPOINTMENT, SALARIES, ALLOWANCES AND MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2016

Bill

to amend the Meghalaya Parliamentary Secretaries (Appointment, Salaries, Allowances and Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2005.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Meghalaya in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows, namely,-

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Meghalaya Parliamentary Secretaries (Appointment, Salaries, Allowances and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 2016.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.

Amendment of section 3.

2. In the Meghalaya Parliamentary Secretaries (Appointment, Salaries, Allowances and Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 2005 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act), in section 3, after the words "Members of the Legislative Assembly" a punctuation full stop "." shall be inserted and thereafter, the words "and assign to each of them such duties and functions as he may deem fit and proper.", shall be omitted.

Substitution of sections 5, 6 and 6A.

3. In the principal Act, for the existing sections 5, 6 and 6A, the following new sections 5, 6 and 6A shall be substituted, namely,-

"Role and functions of Parliamentary Secretary.

"5. A Parliamentary Secretary shall discharge such functions and perform such duties as may be assigned by the Chief Minister for the purposes of effective and regular monitoring of the development works of the Government Departments, from time to time."

"Salaries and allowances of Parliamentary Secretary.

"6. A Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to salaries and allowances as per the Legislative Assembly of Meghalaya (Members' Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1972."

"Other facilities of Parliamentary Secretary.

"6A. A Parliamentary Secretary shall be entitled to such facilities as may be notified by the Government from time to time."

Omission of section 8 of the Act.

4. In the principal Act, section 8 shall be omitted.

STATEMENT OF OBJECT AND REASONS

The Meghalaya Parliamentary Secretaries (Appointment, Salaries, Allowances and Miscellaneous Provisions) (Amendment) Bill, 2016 is proposed to amend Section 3, to replace the existing Section 5, and 6 to insert new Section 6A and to omit Section 8 from the principal Act, in order to provide more clarity on the duties and functions and to utilize their services more effectively for effective and regular development works of different Government departments.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Meghalaya in the Sixty-seventh Year of the Republic of India as follows: -

Short title

- 1. (1) This Act may be called the Meghalaya Appropriation (No III) Act, 2016.
- Withdrawal of ₹.460,84,01,720 from and out of the Consolidated Fund of Meghalaya.
- From and out of the Consolidated 2. fund of Meghalaya there may be paid and applied sums not exceeding those specified Column (3) of the Schedule amounting in the aggregate to the sums of ₹ 460,84,01,720 (Rupees four hundred and sixty crore, eighty four lakh, one thousand seven hundred twenty) only towards defraying the several charges which will come in course of payment during the financial year ending on the thirty first day of March 2017 respect of the services specified in Column (2) of the Schedule.
