
Profile of the 6th Jharkhand Legislative Assembly

Results of the election to the 6th Jharkhand Legislative Assembly were declared on November 23, 2024. The Jharkhand Assembly has 81 seats. This note looks at the profile of the incoming Legislative Assembly.

Most women elected in history of Assembly; 59% of MLAs have college degrees




