
# Profile of the 8th Delhi Legislative Assembly



#### BJP wins majority with 48 out of 70 seats




### Fewer women elected compared to last Assembly; 64% MLAs have completed graduation






### 61% of MLAs have politics or social work as profession; share of young MLAs falls
