## Profile of the 15th Kerala Legislative Assembly


The results of the elections to the 15<sup>th</sup> Kerala Legislative Assembly were declared yesterday. There are 140 assembly seats in the state. In this note, we analyse data on the profile of the incoming Members of Legislative Assembly (MLAs) and compare it with that of the previous Assembly.


### LDF has the majority; CPI(M) is the single largest party with 62 seats


