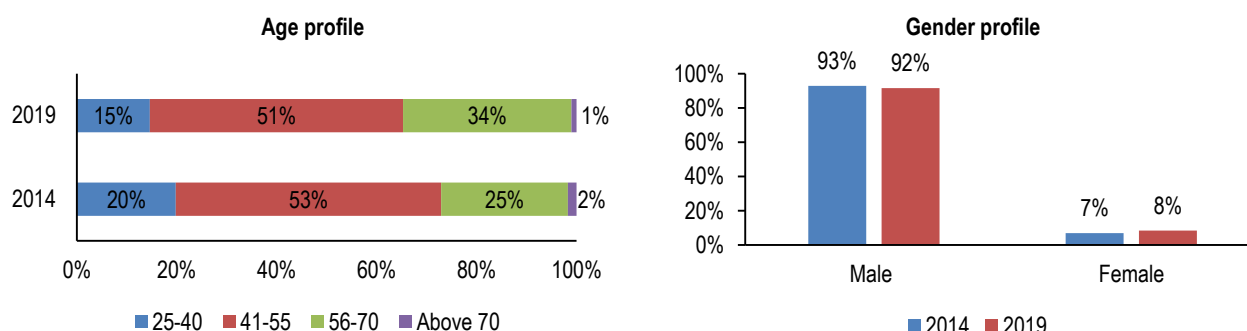
Profile of the 14th Maharashtra Legislative Assembly

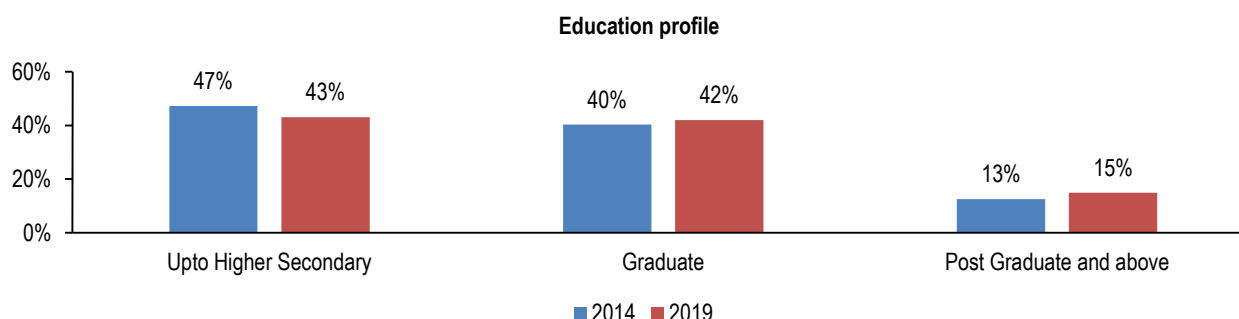
BJP has the highest representation with 105 MLAs
